2. Appointment of an Honorary Freeman of the Borough

On 21 February 2013, the Council resolved as follows:

That Mr. Colin Squire be nominated for appointment as an Honorary Freeman of the Borough.

In light of the above resolution, the Council is asked to consider and pass the following resolution:

Honorary Freeman

Proposed by the Mayor, Councillor Robin Sider.

Seconded by the Leader of the Council, Councillor Robert Watts.

“We, the Mayor and Councillors of Spelthorne Borough Council, in pursuance of Section 249 of the Local Government Act 1972, do confer the title of Honorary Freeman of the Borough of Spelthorne upon Colin Squire, in recognition of the eminent services he has rendered to the Borough and the local community.

This service has been given through: a lifetime’s dedication to research as a member of the Sunbury and Shepperton Local History Society from the age of 17 through to being appointed its President in 1987, a position he still holds; his contribution as a longstanding member and now Chairman of the Spelthorne Civic Awards Trust; being a Governor for over 20 years at Halliford School and trustee for Laleham Parish Lands and Spelthorne Young Voices. We also recognise his generous donations of gifts to charities and contributions of floral displays to beautify the Borough; of particular note are the rose bed in Sunbury Walled Garden and the annual Christmas tree for St Peters’ Church, Laleham Road, Staines-upon-Thames.

We accordingly admit **Colin Squire** to be an Honorary Freeman of the Borough of Spelthorne.”

Note that under Section 249 of the Local Government Act 1972, the passing of the Honorary Freeman resolution by the Council must be by not less than two-thirds of the Members voting thereon.
