1. Licensing Sub-Committee - 29 April 2016

A Licensing Sub-Committee considered a report to determine whether or not Mr T. Lowe was a fit and proper person to hold a Hackney Carriage driver licence. The Sub-Committee resolved to refuse to grant the application for a Hackney Carriage licence for the reasons set out in the decision notice.
