April 2026 – Elections to be held for the shadow Unitary Authority/Authorities

Criteria for Unitary Local Government

- 1. A proposal should seek for the whole for the area concerned the establishment of a single tier of local government.
- 2. Unitary local government must be the right size to achieve efficiencies, improve capacity and withstand financial shocks.
- 3. Unitary structures must prioritise the delivery of high quality and sustainable public services to citizens.
- Proposals should show how councils in the area have sought to work together in coming to a view that meets local needs and is informed by local views.
- 5. New unitary structures must support devolution arrangements.
- 6. New unitary structures should enable stronger community engagement and deliver genuine opportunity for neighbourhood empowerment.
